# 1. 1. Rules and regulations (extracts): these rules and regulations must be respected by all campsite occupants to ensure the safety and peace of mind of all.

#### I. - GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### 1. Conditions of admission and stay

To be allowed to enter, settle or stay on a campsite, you must have been authorised to do so by the manager or his representative. It is the manager's duty to ensure that the campsite is kept in good order and that these internal regulations are complied with.

Staying on the campsite implies acceptance of the provisions of these rules and a commitment to comply with them.

No-one may take up residence on the campsite (...)

#### 4. Reception desk

Open from 8.30am to 12.30pm and from 2.30pm to 8pm in high season (from 1st July to 31st August), from 9am to 12.30pm and from 3pm to 7.30pm in low season. (...)A system for collecting and dealing with complaints is available to customers.

#### 6. Departure arrangements

Customers are asked to inform the reception desk of their departure the day before. Customers intending to leave before the reception desk opens must pay for their stay the day before.

#### 7. Noise and silence

Guests are asked to avoid any noise or discussion that might disturb their neighbours.

Sound equipment must be adjusted accordingly. Door and boot locks must be as discreet as possible.

Dogs and other animals must never be allowed to run at large. They must not be left on the campsite, even locked up, in the absence of their owners, who are civilly responsible for them.(...)

There must be complete silence from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.

#### 8. Visitors

After having been authorised by the manager or his representative, visitors may be admitted to the campsite under the responsibility of the campers receiving them.

(...) Visitors' cars are not allowed on the campsite.

9. Vehicle traffic and parking

Inside the campsite, vehicles must drive at a limited speed.

Traffic is permitted from 7.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m.

Only vehicles belonging to campers staying at the campsite may circulate within the campsite. Parking is strictly forbidden on pitches usually occupied by accommodation unless a parking space has been provided for this purpose. Parking must not hinder traffic or prevent new arrivals from settling in.

10. Behaviour and appearance of facilities

Everyone is required to refrain from any action that could damage the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite and its facilities, particularly sanitary facilities.

It is forbidden to dispose of waste water on the ground or in the gutters. Washing vehicles is forbidden on the campsite.

Customers must empty waste water into the facilities provided for this purpose. Household waste and rubbish of any kind must be disposed of in the rubbish bins in accordance with the sorting instructions (...)

Planting and floral decorations must be respected. It is forbidden to put nails in trees, cut branches or plant trees.

It is forbidden to mark out the location of an installation by personal means, or to dig up the ground. Any damage to vegetation, fences, grounds or campsite facilities will be paid for by the person responsible.

11. Safety

a) Fire.

Open fires (wood, coal, etc.) are strictly prohibited.

Stoves must be kept in good working order and must not be used in dangerous conditions.

In the event of fire, notify the management immediately. Fire extinguishers may be used if necessary.

A first aid kit is available at the reception desk.

b) Theft.

The management is responsible for items left at the office and has a general obligation to monitor the campsite. Campers remain responsible for their own facilities and must report the presence of any suspicious person to the manager. Customers are asked to take the usual precautions to safeguard their equipment.



#### 12. Games

No violent or disruptive games may be played in the vicinity of the facilities. The meeting room may not be used for boisterous games. Children must always be supervised by their parents.

#### 13. Dead garage

Unoccupied equipment may only be left on the pitch with the agreement of the management, and only in the location indicated. There is a charge for this service.

#### 14. Infringement of the campsite rules


In the event that a resident disrupts the stay of other users or does not respect the provisions of these internal rules, the manager or his representative may, orally or in writing, if he deems it necessary, give formal notice to the resident to cease the disturbance.

In the event of serious or repeated breaches of these rules and regulations, and after the manager has served formal notice to comply, the contract may be terminated.

In the event of a criminal offence, the manager may call in the police.

#### 2.campsite map, services and facilities :

- Wi-Fi is available exclusively around the campsite's living areas: reception, TV room, bar (you will be given the access code at reception).
- The children's play area is open all year round under parental supervision and in compliance with the posted instructions (age of children, number of simultaneous users, etc.).
- The campsite also has a table tennis table and petanque, volleyball and football pitches. Equipment (balls, rackets) can be borrowed from reception.
- Board games are available at the bar.
- A library is available in the TV room.
- A washing machine (€4.50 without detergent, €5.50 with detergent, booking required during the summer), ironing board and iron are available on the campsite. A dedicated heated room is available for drying your washing (please do not hang out your washing in the sanitary facilities).
- A cot, changing mat and bathtub are available on loan. Please ask at reception.
- If you need to, you can leave your valuables with us.
- Hairdryers are available on loan from reception.
- Bottles of gas on sale here (13 kg propane).
- In winter: dedicated room for storing skis and boots.
- Bread, pastries and full breakfasts available in season and by prior arrangement.



#### 3. Tourist information:

Here's some tourist information about places of interest near Vielle-Aure:

La base de loisirs d'Agos: situated close to the campsite, this is a peaceful spot surrounded by mountains. It's an ideal place to relax, picnic and enjoy nature. You can also fish here (subject to regulations).

Saint-Lary-Soulan: just a few kilometres from Vielle-Aure is the famous ski resort of Saint-Lary-Soulan. In winter, you can enjoy downhill and cross-country skiing, as well as other winter activities. In summer, the resort offers hiking trails, mountain bike trails, white-water activities and cultural events. The thermal baths of Saint-Lary are also renowned for their beneficial thermal waters. Enjoy a relaxing session in the hot springs and treatments offered by Sensoria to recharge your batteries after a day of activities.

**Pyrenees National Park**: this national park is a real natural gem, offering spectacular scenery, majestic peaks, verdant valleys and a wealth of flora and fauna. You can enjoy hiking, birdwatching, guided tours and other outdoor activities in the park.

**Col d'Azet**: this mountain pass is renowned for its breathtaking views. It can be reached by car, bike or on foot. Once at the top, you can admire the surrounding peaks and Alpine scenery before heading off to neighbouring Vallée du Louron for a stroll around Lac de Génos or a wellness session at Balnéa.

**Arreau**: visit this enchanting Pyrenean village nestling in the heart of the Aure Valley. With its picturesque charm, cobbled streets and traditional stone houses, Arreau transports you to the authenticity of the South West. Explore its rich heritage, visit its lively market (every Thursday morning) and soak up the warm atmosphere of this pearl of the Pyrenees.

#### 4. Emergency procedures:

#### **IIN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT :**

First of all, notify reception on 05 62 39 40 64. Or 07 82 89 93 30 (outside reception opening hours). Depending on the accident, call : The fire brigade on 18 Emergency services on 15 The police on 17 Or for all emergencies 112.

#### **IN CASE OF FIRE**

Above all, KEEP CALM. First of all, notify reception. on 05 62 39 40 64 or 06 24 56 75 93 Then call the fire brigade on 18. Attack the fire with fire extinguishers without taking any risks. If you are trapped in the smoke, bend down to get closer to the fresh air near the ground.

#### IN THE EVENT OF EVACUATION

As soon as you are told to evacuate, get out immediately. Then follow the instructions given. Leave your vehicle where it is. Then head for the Assembly points : THE CAR PARK AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE CAMPSITE. **Above all, don't go back!**


